PARK OPENING INFORMATION

The Park is public open space and is open all the time.
The main car park is open daily 8-6pm, locked at 6pm.

The Café is open daily visit www.intheorchard.co.uk with any queries and opening hours.
The Café will be open over the Christmas period but closed Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Years Day.

The toilets are open when the Café is open.
When closed the nearest public toilets are in Shenley Village, next to the Village Hall.

The main play area will be closed Christmas Day.

The Walled Garden is open weekdays only from October to Easter, 12-4pm.
It is additionally closed 24th and 25th December.
