

Our annual family music event Music to Watch the Flowers By will not be held this year but we hope to be adding two alternative music events to our calendar, details to follow on our website.


A smaller scale Apple Day is planned for Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> October in the Walled Garden. A celebration of Apples, details to follow nearer the time.
